



# Gymnastics NSW

## 2023 Region Sanctioned Competition & Events

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Gymnastics NSW encourages all regions and clubs to run appropriate events across the various Gymsports to assist with engagement and capacity building across the state. Access to regular grassroots competitions, offered at the local level which are easily accessible to athletes and their families, clubs and officials are essential to the growth and development of gymnastics across the community and the support of local clubs and their businesses. Region and local competitions form the basis of life long participation in gymnastics, and the engagement of the community through fun and inspiring events.

To assist regions and clubs in delivering successful and enjoyable events, this document will outline the responsibilities and required documentation to sanction your event.

Organisers, clubs, hosts and committees need to have an implementation plan that flows from the Gymnastics NSW policies and procedures, ensuring compliance with all current regulations and requirements. These guidelines are designed to ensure the safety and health of both the gymnastic and wider community. Working together we all can participate safely.

Any club or region looking to host a competition or event in 2023 must complete the Event Sanctioning Application and must comply with all current government and health restrictions.

## Event Definitions

- **Region Event - Applications due 5pm, Monday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022**  
A qualifier or non-qualifier hosted by Gymnastics NSW Region Committee. For a region sanctioned event, applications need to come through the Regional Supervisor or nominated representative. Applications for regional events will **not** be accepted through an individual club. Regions must follow the qualifying event application process outlined below.

Sanctioned qualifiers are required to be run in MAG, TeamGym, TRP and WAG.

## Region Event Process

Prior to the Region requesting to sanction an event, Gymnastics NSW Club and Region Development Officer (CRDO) will meet with the region committee to identify the events the region plans to host within the calendar year. Please refer to the Appendix 1 for details on the events required to be run in each of the regions, as well as helpful calendar planning tools.

Regions must develop a comprehensive competition calendar in conjunction with the CRDOs ensuring they have included all competitions which are required to be held within each region, which does not conflict with the GNSW State Event Calendar. Under extenuating circumstances a Region may apply for the sanctioning and organisation of an event held outside of their Region.

When planning for the competition the Region is required to liaise with the host club in relation to the event hosting costs, capacity limits including spectator numbers, available and required equipment meeting safety standards, any and all current government restrictions and requirements relating to the running of the event and completion of all required documentation. The Region will also liaise with the CRDO to develop the event budget and risk matrix for each of the planned events.

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## Events Regions are required to host

Each Region and/or Zone (combination of region(s) for the purposes of competition) is required to run a number of sanctioned qualification events across the gymsports which form a vital part of the athlete qualification and selection pathway.

Qualification and selection events are required to be run in MAG, Team Gym, TRP and WAG. If the required qualification competitions are not held within each region, the clubs and athletes from that region will not be eligible to participate in the relevant State trials and State Championship competitions.

Regions will be represented by region teams at the State Championships in MAG, TeamGym, TRP and WAG. Teams selected from region qualification and selection competitions will accumulate points for their region with champion teams and regions awarded in each sport.

Regions are encouraged to run additional competitions or activities particularly in other gymsports and other levels. We encourage regions to consider running events such as:

- preparation and feedback competitions in the lead up to state and national qualification competitions
- friendly participation events
- regional championships

Regions are also required to run lower level events and may consider running out of season events at alternate times during the year to provide opportunities for greater participation in a low pressure environment prior to region selection or qualification events.

Access to regular grassroots competitions, offered at the local level which are easily accessible to athletes and their families, clubs and officials are essential to the growth and development of gymnastics across the community and the support of local clubs and their businesses. Region competitions form the basis of life long participation in gymnastics, and the engagement of the community through fun and inspiring events.

Region Committees and affiliated clubs must adhere to the GNSW competition calendar when seeking sanctioning of events to:

- avoid clashes of dates of important competitions within the same gymsport and level
- respect the State and Australian Championships Qualification calendar
- respect the competitions and activities organised by GNSW

### Region Zones

Regions grouped together for competition based on the current competition demographics, the statistical participation trends, the number of clubs within each region, the current and developing workforce capacity including technical expertise and coaching and judging capacity, as well as growth and development within in each region.

Zones can hold multiple events based on the gymsport qualification requirements and selection process. Where multiple events can be held, this is recommended and wherever possible these events should be held across each of the Regions within the Zone to provide local opportunities for participation. Where events cannot be held across the Regions, multiple events can be sanctioned in the same Region which is part of a zone. It is also suggested to consider alternating the host Region for the Zone events each year. The Region in which a Zone competition is held is the 'Host' and sanctioning region for the event, responsible for the event organisation and delivery with the support of the other Regions in the Zone.

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# Region Event Planning & Requirements

## Venue Checks

For all event approvals:

- Venue safety briefing and emergency evacuation plan must have been received by the region and host club and this must be communicated to all participating clubs, as well as on the day.
- You **must** complete the Equipment Risk Assessment on the provided template which must be completed prior to the commencement of the competition and submitted to GNSW following the event.
- Supply a venue that is suitable to host the event and supply all the competition equipment for the event.
- The region committee members and event coordinators have a duty of care to ensure that the equipment is safe for competition. The event must be conducted in a venue sanctioned by GNSW and the equipment must be, as a minimum standard, safe for competition and safe for the activities that will be performed on it. The minimum safe standard for competition is relative to gym sport, level and activities and modifications to the apparatus specifications as set in the relative ALP/technical regulations or other applicable document may be appropriate for a sanctioned region competition.
- Agreement to complete the Equipment safety checklist document and send through post event.

## Region Competition Fees

Please see your CRDO for the minimum and recommended fees for the regional activities. The fee for competitions should be set in consultation with the Regional Committee and the Gymnastics NSW CRDO with the completed event budgets.

## Entry Forms and Entries

Regions are required to complete the GNSW Competition Entry form template which has been created by a GNSW staff member. Regions will need to enter the details of the event into the created template and submit the form with their competition sanctioning application.

The competition entry form will be posted on the GNSW website once the event has been sanctioned. Competitions will not be sanctioned if participants from a non-affiliated club participate in the event.

Regions must ensure they communicate to the clubs within their region and that they are aware that it is the club's responsibility to ensure all athletes and officials are current registered members (with the correct level of accreditation) prior to submitting entries, and those officials' technical registrations will still be current on the day of the event. Clubs must ensure that all Coaches and Judges registered for their Club have a current relationship registered at the Club in the Club Admin Portal, on the Tech Member tab before registering them for any event.

All entries will be received by GNSW and forwarded as received onto the regional supervisor or nominated representative. All entries must be completed on the official entry form in excel and submitted through the online link on the GNSW website. Entry forms must be correctly filled out with all requested information. Forms received that are incomplete or incorrectly filled out will not be accepted and the region supervisor or competition administrator will return the entry form to the club for correction and resubmission.

Region competition entries will close a minimum of 3 weeks prior to the competition date. Late entry fees are applicable as per the GNSW Technical Regulations and can be administered at the discretion of the regional supervisor.

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All region competitions must be conducted in accordance with the GNSW Technical Regulations, GNSW Terms and Conditions and GNSW Policies. Additional event regulations which are set by the Region for each event(s) must be included on their region competition entry form. Regions should check any proposed Region entry regulation with their Region CRDO prior to completing this section of the competition entry form. Regions are required to include all clubs within their region for their events. Regions may nominate if they are able to accept entries from outside of their designated region/zone based on event capacity.

## Judging Panels

It is the responsibility of the region to be familiar with, and adhere to, the judging requirements for event sanctioning. If panels do not meet the minimum standard following the event, GNSW reserves the right to withdraw the sanction.

Regions are responsible for compiling Judges Panels with nominated registered judges. All Judges must have appropriate accreditation for the competition level (refer to specific [Gymsport Technical Regulations](#)).

Regions should consult with the relevant Gymsport Judging Coordinator / Judges Assembly for guidance and advice in compiling the Judges Panels for their competition(s).

Final Judges Panels must be submitted to GNSW following the conclusion of the event in the Post-Event documentation.

## First-Aid

It is the region's responsibility to source and supply a dedicated first aid officer with a current First Aid and CPR Certificate for the event.

Regions must supply a dedicated first aid area at each event with up to date first aid equipment, ice and ice-bags.

At competitions regions must complete and submit a Medical Injury Report Form (located on the GNSW Sanctioned Event Information page on the GNSW website) for any incident that occurred at the event. Immediately following the event, copies of all reports must be forwarded to GNSW.

## Event Trade Stalls

Regions should consider any trade stalls and suppliers who may be able to attend the sanctioned competitions. Attendance at sanctioned events will be dependent on venue space, capacity and event requirements. If trade and supplier stalls are permitted at the Region Event, GNSW sponsors (Sinalli Sportswear, Sylvia P Leotards and HART Sport) must be offered the right to attend the event. Regions are not permitted to allow suppliers to attend and promote products that conflict with any GNSW commercial or sponsorship agreement or the GNSW Sponsorship policy.

## Awards

Region competitions awards must be presented in accordance with structure as set out in the relevant Gymsport Technical Regulations.

Regions may contact GNSW for assistance in ordering and purchasing medals and ribbons for region competitions. Due to lead times regions should identify if they require assistance in this area at the time of competition planning to ensure awards are ordered and received in sufficient time for all events. Regions should contact their CRDO for assistance.

## Results and Scoring

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Utilise an effective digital result system. Competition scoring and result templates are available for each gymnsport.

Results are to be submitted to GNSW with the post-event documentation within 24hrs of the conclusion of the competition. Results must be submitted as electronic copies, in PDF format, ready for posting on the GNSW website. Please ensure that the competition name and date is visible at the top of the results page(s). Competitor personal information (such as Date of Birth) should not be included in results for publishing on the website or in any results sent to clubs.

## Region Competition Sanctioning Process

Once event planning is complete the Region should follow the procedure as outlined below.

- Region Sanctioning Application Form - [Available on the GNSW website](#)

Application forms must be submitted via the online sanctioned event application available on the Sanctioned Competition page on the Gymnastics NSW website. Contained within the submission, the following documents must be prepared and uploaded;

**To apply to host a Sanctioned event within the state of NSW, hosts MUST complete all points within the application process. Incomplete applications will be returned.**

1. Development of Region Competition Calendar- Planning Meeting with Clubs & Committee
2. Approval of Region Competition Calendar by GNSW
3. Complete Region Sanctioning Application Form for each event
4. Complete Sanctioning Documents
  - Emergency Evacuation Plan
    - for a GNSW affiliated club venue (submitted during club affiliation – not required to be resubmitted)
    - for non-affiliated club venue an emergency evacuation plan must be submitted.
    - Acknowledgment Region has a copy of the venue evacuation plan and any required venue safety briefing
  - Event Budget to be completed with GNSW CRDO
  - Event Risk Matrix to be completed with GNSW CRDO
  - Entry Form
5. Submit Region Sanctioning Application and Sanctioning Documents
6. Application evaluated by GNSW and approval will be granted if all requirements are met.
7. Completed competition sanctioning applications must be submitted by **5pm Monday, 12<sup>th</sup> December 2022.**

## Region Event Approval Process

Following the submission of the event sanctioning paperwork the documentation will be reviewed for approval.

- **Region Sanctioned Events (Qualifying & Non-qualifying Events)**
  - For an event to be sanctioned as a qualifier for a NSW State event, the event application **must** be conducted and completed **prior** to the published closing date for entries into that respective State event.
  - All applications will be evaluated by GNSW for approval. Once finalised, regions will be notified of their approval/non-approval via email. Approved sanctioned event will be placed on the GNSW Region Activities Calendar on the GNSW website.
  - All region Sanctioned event applications must come through the region supervisor or nominated representative. Applications for region events will not be accepted by individual clubs.

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**ALL event sanction application forms must be returned via the official [JotForm](#).**

In the event that there is a change to the approved competition (venue, date etc) the region is required to contact their CRDO to discuss this change and provide any additional documentation for the competition to proceed and maintain approved sanctioning status. In some instances the competition may require re-sanctioning.

Gymnastics NSW has the authority to remove sanctioning of any event if the requirements and conditions of sanctioning are not met.

## Post Region Competition Process and Documents

All Documents below must be completed and submit online post event.

**On the IMMEDIATE MONDAY after your event, the following information MUST be sent to GNSW:**

1. Equipment safety checklists (completed before the commencement of the competition)
2. Event summary report / reconciliation - available online and in Appendix 2.
3. Electronic copies of **all** results, in PDF format, ready for posting on the GNSW website
  - a. Please ensure that the competition name and date is visible at the top of the results page(s)
4. A list of the final judges panels for each session
  - a. List must include judges accreditations - if this information is not included, GNSW reserves the right to withdraw the sanction
  - b. Clubs hosting events risk the disqualification of scores if unqualified judges are on panels at sanctioned events
5. A copy of any accident or injury reports relating to the competition

**All documents must be submitted by the online jotform.**

## Region Teams

### Introduction

Regions will be represented by region teams at the State Championships in MAG, TeamGym, TRP and WAG. Teams selected from region qualification and selection competitions will accumulate points for their region with champion teams and regions awarded in each sport. Regions are required to select teams in MAG, TRP and WAG. These teams will compete at their respective event as detailed below:

- MAG Level 1-6 at Junior State Championships
- TRP State Levels 1-7 at State Levels Championships
- WAG Level 3 - 4 at Junior State Championships

### Region Team Uniform

Sinalli Sportswear and Sylvia P Leotards are the Official GNSW supplier for all uniform and competition wear including for GNSW Regions. All Region uniform items for competition, squads and promotional usage must be through the official GNSW suppliers. If there are any changes to supplier regions are required to use the current Gymnastics NSW official supplier at the time. No exemptions will be granted for existing or carry-over stock.

### MAG, TeamGym and TRP

- Regions are not required to have athletes competing in regions teams in region uniform and gymnasts will compete in club attire.

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- Regions may wish to have a region t-shirt or similar. Where regions have decided to have region items for their team/s such as a t-shirt, these items must only be designed and ordered through Gymnastics NSW official uniform suppliers.
  - For outer wear items such as t-shirts or jackets the supplier must be Sinalli Sportswear

## WAG

- Regions are not required to have athletes competing in regions teams in region uniform. Regions may decide to compete in club attire.
- Where regions have decided to have region items for their team/s such as a t-shirt or leotard, these items must only be designed and ordered through Gymnastics NSW partner uniform suppliers.
  - For competition wear (leotards and shorts) the supplier must be Sylvia P
  - For outer wear items such as t-shirts or jackets the supplier must be Sinalli Sportswear
- Where a region is implementing a Region leotard (competitive wear item), provision of inclusive uniform options in line with the GNSW uniform guidelines must be provided.

## Gymsport Selection Policies

### MAG

Each region/zone will hold a region team selection and qualification competition for levels 1-6.

- Selection competitions are recommended to be held on the weekend 26<sup>th</sup>/27<sup>th</sup> August (must be held before the 25<sup>th</sup> September)
- Each region/zone will select 1 team of 5 athletes (minimum 3 athletes) per level (age and open combined as per the below table)

- No qualification score required for selection to region team, Level 3-6 individuals will be selected for Region teams at the sanctioned Region team qualification event, however must qualify through the GNSW Grand Prix competitions. If an individual is selected to the region team who has not achieved the State Championships qualification score as an individual, the athlete will not be able to attend the State Championships. Under this circumstance the region may fill the team vacancy with the next ranked athlete who has met the qualification criteria from the selection competition.
- Region teams will consist of the top 5 ranked athletes in each division from the region selection event
- Some regions have been combined into competition zones and zone teams are to be selected. Selection will be across the top 5 athletes in the Zone.
  - Hunter Region
  - Northern Region

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- Inner City
- Met West Region
- Southern Zone
  - Outer City Region
  - Southern Region
  - South Coast Region
- Central West and North West Regional NSW Zone
  - Far North Coast
  - North West Region
  - Central West Region
  - Riverina Region
- For the region team competition at the State Championships, a combined team consisting of the Central West region zone and North West regional Zone will be formed. The two zones may hold separate team selection events with the Central West Zone allocated 2 of the available 5 team positions and the North West Zone allocated the remaining 3 team positions. If one of the zones is unable to fill their allocated team positions the positions will be filled by the next ranked athlete/s from the other zone.

## TeamGym

Each region will hold a minimum of 2 TeamGym region team selection and qualification competitions.

Regions will select one TeamGym team to represent the region at the State Championships in each of the following divisions:

- Novice
- Intermediate
- Advanced

Regions teams will be selected across the 2 TeamGym region selection and qualifying competitions. The region team in each division will be the team with the highest average score across the 2 selection competitions.

## TRP

Each region/zone will hold a minimum of 1 region team selection and qualification competition for State Levels 1-7.

- Each region/zone will select 1 team of 3 athletes (minimum 2 athletes) per level per discipline as per the below table. Teams can be combined gender male/female.

DMT Level 5/6/7	Top 3 ranked gymnasts from combined age/open scores at qualification competition

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TUM Level 1	Top 3 ranked gymnasts from combined age/open scores at qualification competition
TUM Level 2	Top 3 ranked gymnasts from combined age/open scores at qualification competition
TUM Level 3	Top 3 ranked gymnasts from combined age/open scores at qualification competition
TUM Level 4	Top 3 ranked gymnasts from combined age/open scores at qualification competition
TUM Level 5/6/7	Top 3 ranked gymnasts from combined age/open scores at qualification competition

- Region teams will consist of the top 3 (minimum 2) ranked athletes in each division from the region selection event
- Some regions have been combined into competition zones and zone teams are to be selected. Selection will be across the top 3 athletes in the Zone.
  - Zone 1
    - Northern Region
    - Inner City Region
  - Zone 2
    - Met West Region
  - Zone 3
    - Outer City Region
    - Southern Region
    - South Coast Region
  - Zone 4
    - Hunter Region
    - North West Region
    - Far North Coast Region
  - Zone 5
    - Central West Region

## WAG

Each region/zone will hold a minimum of 1 region team selection and qualification competition for levels 3 and 4.

- As per the 2023 WAG Technical Regulations regions are required to select 8 teams per level for the Junior State Championships
- No qualification score required for selection to region team, Level 3 and 4 individuals will be selected for Region teams at the sanctioned Region team qualification event
- Region team allocation/order of work is listed in the 2023 WAG Technical Regulations and regions are required to enter their teams with the designated team number according to this draw
- Some regions have been combined into competition zones and zone teams are to be selected
  - Southern
  - Northern
  - Met West
  - Inner City
  - Outer City
  - North West
  - Hunter
  - South Coast
  - Far North Coast
  - Central West / Riverina\*
    - Central West/Riverina is for the selection of a combined Regions Team for the Level 3 & 4 Region State Championships.
- Regions must fill each team before starting gymnast allocation within the next team (exception for the last teams to be filled where if there are only 6 or 7 gymnasts remaining 2 teams can be formed)

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- Regions may not set any additional qualification requirements such as a minimum score. Regions are not permitted to select less than the permitted number of positions. E.g. in WAG where 8 teams in Level 3 are eligible to compete, a region may not choose to select and send only 4 teams.
- Where regions have additional gymnasts seeking selection for the State Championships regions may submit these teams to a waiting list. Following finalisation of entries from all regions available positions will be allocated to teams from the waiting list.

When setting the region selection policy (which is required to be submitted as part of the event sanctioning for qualification events), consideration should be given to the following factors:

- Number of selection events to be held and their timing relative to Gymnastics NSW entry timelines for relevant event
  - Regions may consider having a single selection event or multiple selection events
- Selection Criteria
  - The selection policy should cover what the process of selection will be. Option may include:
    - If it is a single selection event, selection may be straight down the list for the number of available positions
    - If selection is taking part over multiple selection events, the region will need to consider how the selection will take place. Options may include the highest score from each gymnast being used, or the average of the competitions.
  - The selection policy should cover how the gymnasts will be allocated to teams
    - Options may include teams allocated in selection rank order, or by grouping clubs
  - Regions should consider if they will accept Special Considerations in team selection
    - Will there be any provision for special consideration?
      - If no, this needs to be specified
      - If yes, what is this eligibility criteria for consideration
      - Regions are not required to include a provision for special considerations and should carefully consider the implications and application within the required timelines for entry to the NSW State Championships
      - Please note any special considerations for athletes who have not met the GNSW eligibility criteria for the State Championships would also need to submit a request for special consideration to Gymnastics NSW. Applications for considerations are not guaranteed to be accepted.

## Provision of Judges for GNSW State Championships Competitions

### MAG, TeamGym and TRP

Judges will be supplied by clubs in accordance with the Provision of Judges Policy.

### WAG

Regions will be required to nominate 3 judges for each session that they have gymnasts competing in. Where a region has additional teams they will be required to submit 1 judge for each additional team in a session as well as the 3 judges required.
