Introduction

This policy has been developed by Gymnastics NSW to recognise people who have contributed to gymnastics in New South Wales and excelled within the sport. The policy is based around the selection of two (2) categories of awards:

1. Contributed Efforts Awards e.g. Merit and Service Awards, Life Member Awards
2. Awards of Excellence e.g. Club, Coach and Athlete of the Year Awards

Contributed Efforts Awards

Overriding criteria for all Contributed Effort Awards shall include the requirement that recipients shall demonstrate at all times the highest standards of personal conduct, sportsmanship, integrity and participation to the benefit of the sport.

11 Award Types

1.1.1 Life Member Awards

A person who has contributed sustained and outstanding voluntary service to Gymnastics NSW over a long period of time in the order of 15 years.

1.1.2 Service Awards

A person who has contributed sustained and outstanding voluntary service to Gymnastics NSW over a long period of time in the order of 10 years.

1.1.3 Merit Awards

A person who has contributed sustained and outstanding voluntary service to Gymnastics NSW over a long period of time in the order of 5 years.

1.1.4 Volunteer Recognition Awards

A person who has contributed outstanding voluntary service to Gymnastics NSW during a particular year.

1.1.5 Judge Recognition Awards

A judge who has contributed outstanding services to Judging for Gymnastics NSW during a particular year.

1.1.6 Region Volunteer Recognition Awards

A person who has contributed sustained and outstanding service to a Region over a long period of time in the order of 5 years.

1.2 Nomination and Selection Process

Nominations for the above award categories shall be in writing on the prescribed nomination forms (if applicable) and sent to the Gymnastics NSW Office. All nominations will be considered by the Gymnastics NSW Board of Directors in its absolute discretion, with appointments made based on the award criteria and the eligibility of the nominee.

1.3 Announcement and Presentation

In most cases the standard practice will be to call for nominations from December each year, with the nomination forms available to all members of Gymnastics NSW. The nominations will be considered by the Board of Directors during January. The presentation of the successful nominees will be held in conjunction with the Gymnastics NSW Annual Awards Dinner, held at a time deemed suitable by the Board of Directors. This does not preclude awards being determined and presented at other times in the absolute discretion of the Board of Directors.

Awards of Excellence

Overriding criteria for all Awards of Excellence to either organisations or individuals shall include the requirement that recipients shall demonstrate at all times the highest standards of personal conduct, sportsmanship, integrity and participation to the benefit of the sport.

2.3 NSW Club of the Year (Sport Specific)

This award is presented to the best performing affiliated club in each of the gymnastic sport areas: Men's Artistic, Women's Artistic, Rhythmic, Gymnastics for All, Sport Aerobics, Acrobatic Gymnastics and Trampoline Sports. *Exception:* KinderGym will be by nomination.

2.4 NSW Coach of the Year (Sport Specific)

This award is presented to the coach in NSW with the best results at events or competitions during the current calendar year. The award shall be presented to Levels and International coaches (as applicable and appropriate) for all competitive gym sports plus Gymnastics for All. KinderGym will be by nomination.

2.5 NSW Athlete of the Year (Sport Specific)

This award is presented to the best performing athletes from NSW during the course of the current year. The Athlete awards are based on results and representation at all levels.

2.8 NSW Overall Club of the Year

This award is presented to the club who is judged to be the best overall club in NSW, taking into account all of the sports, participation numbers, volunteers, state team representation, regional involvement etc.

- Nominations should include the completed nomination form plus supporting information.
- Information supplied may be utilised by Gymnastics NSW for promotional purposes.
- The GfA Gymsport Committee will be the Selection Committee and reserve the right to non-award if nominations don't meet criteria.
- The selection panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered.
- All nominations must be endorsed by the relevant Club delegate; nominations from the Committee must be advised to the state GfA Events and Development Officer.
- Gymnastics NSW must receive nominations by the closing date.
- Presentations occur at the GNSW Annual Awards night.

KinderGym Nomination Criteria - Club of the Year

- Nominees will be assessed on achievements and/or initiatives developed and implemented over the previous 12 months (October 31 - October 31).

Process

- GNSW will request nominations from NSW clubs.
- Clubs put forward one nomination for KinderGym Club of the Year.
- The GfA Gymsport Committee will have the ability to nominate a Club if no club nominations are received.
- Nominations should include the completed nomination form plus supporting information.
- Information supplied may be utilised by Gymnastics NSW for promotional purposes
- The GfA Gymsport Committee will be the Selection Committee and reserve the right to non-award if nominations don't meet criteria.
- The selection panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered.
- All nominations must be endorsed by the relevant Club delegate; nominations from the Committee must be advised to the state GfA Events and Development Officer.
- Gymnastics NSW must receive nominations by the closing date.
- Presentations occur at the GNSW Annual Awards night.

- Clubs put forward one nomination for KinderGym Coach of the Year.
- The GfA Gymsport Committee will have the ability to nominate a person for the award if a club fails to nominate a suitably qualified person.
- Nominations should include the completed nomination form plus supporting information
- Information supplied may be utilised by Gymnastics NSW for promotional purposes.
- The GfA Gymsport Committee will be the Selection Committee and reserve the right to non-award if nominations don't meet criteria.
- The selection panel's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered.
- All nominations must be endorsed by the relevant Club delegate; nominations from the Committee must be advised to the state GfA Events and Development Officer.
- Gymnastics NSW must receive nominations by the closing date.
- Presentations occur at the GNSW Annual Awards night.

Selection Criteria

- Describe the dedication, achievement or contribution that has been made by the accredited KinderGym Coach. Explain how this has promoted and encouraged participation in Gymnastics and ensured the development and delivery of quality KinderGym programs.
- Describe how the coach supports and contributes to the philosophy and goals of KinderGym.
- Describe any significant changes that have occurred as a result of the coach's involvement in KinderGym.

There is no limit as to the number of times an affiliated Club may be nominated and/or receive this award.

Nominee Endorsement

All Club nominations must be endorsed by the Club owner/director or voting delegate.

Committee Endorsement

The award winner selected by the GfA Gymsport Committee must be ratified by Gymnastics NSW prior to presentation of the awards.

3.5 NSW Athlete of the Year (Sport Specific)

Athletes nominated for awards will be listed as representing the club they are currently registered with at the time of the nomination.

3.6 Young Leader of the Year Award

The selection for the Young Leader of the Year Award will be based on the relevant Point Score system below, and clubs are not required to nominate, or be nominated for these awards. In the event of a tie based on Point Score, the GNSW Board will determine the Award Winner considering any relevant criteria.

Small, Medium and Large Club Award

A Small Club Award, Medium Club Award and Large Club Award shall be awarded each year according to the following criteria:

1. Eligibility:

- 1.1 To be eligible for an award the:
 - 1.1.1 Small club must have fewer than 300 members.
 - 1.1.2 Medium club must have between 300 and 1000 members.
 - 1.1.3 Large club must have greater than 1000 members.
 - 1.1.4 An application must be received that:
 - 1.1.4.1 Complies with the guidelines set out on the application form.
 - 1.1.4.2 Responds to all questions in a true and honest manner.
 - 1.1.4.3 Provides references and supporting information if and when required.

2. Nomination and Selection Process:

- 2.1 Nominations shall be called via the website and Facebook and shall be open for 28 days.
- 2.2 Applications must be submitted using the official nomination form.
- 2.3 The nomination form shall include:
 - 2.3.1 the due date for submission,
 - 2.3.2 the method of submission,
 - 2.3.3 the areas where information from the club is sought in accordance with clause 4.
- 2.4 Following the closing date of applications, Eligible applications received shall be referred to a Nomination Committee who shall deliberate in accordance with clause 5.
- 2.5 The Nomination Committee shall meet and assess the nominations with the view to determining the five finalists in each category ('the list of finalists').
- 2.6 The list of finalists shall be subject to ratification by the Board of Management in accordance with clause 6.
- 2.7 Once ratified, Gymnastics NSW shall open an online survey tool which provides the community with an opportunity to determine the winner in each category by voting for their preferred club. Each finalist will have a summary of its achievements posted online for the consideration of the membership. The club that receives the highest number of votes shall win the award in each category. The online voting tool shall be open for 14 days.
- 2.8 The list of finalists shall be invited to the Annual Awards Dinner each year where the award shall be presented.

3. Assessment criteria:

- 3.1 Clubs in all three categories of this award shall be asked to submit information in the following areas:
 - 3.1.1 Participation including:
 - 3.1.1.1 Membership numbers
 - 3.1.1.2 Growth in members
 - 3.1.1.3 User visits
 - 3.1.1.4 Workforce
 - 3.1.1.5 Growth in workforce
 - 3.1.1.6 Participation programs delivered at the club
 - 3.1.2 Event results at state, national and international level (a summary of results is sufficient)
 - 3.1.3 Contribution to the sport via:
 - 3.1.3.1 Participation on committees
 - 3.1.3.2 Number of judges
 - 3.1.4 Club development and promotional activities including:
 - 3.1.4.1 Staff training
 - 3.1.4.2 Disability programs
 - 3.1.4.3 Leadership programs

3.1.4.4 Promotional activities

3.1.5 Any other club special initiatives.

4. Nomination Committee:

4.1 Terms of Reference

The Selection Committee is responsible for selecting, pending final ratification by the Board of Management, five finalists for each of the small, medium and large club award categories ('the list of finalists').

4.2 Membership

The membership of the Selection Committee shall consist of:

4.2.1 The Chief Executive, who shall also act as Chair

4.2.2 A Life Member determined by the Board

4.2.3 A Technical Director determined by the Board, and

4.2.4 A Regional Supervisor determined by the Board.

4.3 Quorum

The quorum for meetings of the Selection Committee shall be 100%. Delegates may attend either in person or via teleconference.

4.4 Selection

The selection of the award finalists shall be by majority vote. In the event of a tied vote the meeting chair shall have the casting vote.

5. Referral to Board of Management:

5.1 Requirement to ratify

When the list of finalists has been agreed upon by the Nomination Committee the list of finalists must be provided to the Board of management for final ratification. The successful applicants must not be advised of nomination until ratified by the Board.

5.2 Process

The Board of Management shall ratify the list of finalists in accordance with the rules for the operation of the Board of Management.

5.3 Refusal to ratify

The Board of Management may refuse to ratify one or more of the list of finalists on one or more of the following grounds:

5.3.1 The finalist does not meet the eligibility criteria.

5.3.2 The finalist has, in the sole opinion of the Board of Management, previously brought the sport into disrepute or has acted in a way that a reasonable person would think would bring the sport into disrepute.

5.3.3 The club has not acted in the interests of Gymnastics NSW and/or in a sportsmanlike manner.

5.3.4 Any other reasonably determined reason.

6. Appeal

The decision by the Nomination Committee, ratification by the Board of Management and the final vote count via the survey tool is definitive and may not be appealed under any Gymnastics NSW policy.

3.8 NSW Overall Club of the Year

Overriding criteria for all awards of excellence to either organizations or individuals shall include the requirement that recipients shall demonstrate at all times the highest standards of personal conduct, sportsmanship, integrity and participation to the benefit of the sport.

This award is presented to the club who is judged to be the best overall club in NSW, taking into account all of the sports, participation numbers, volunteers, state team representation, regional involvement etc.
